Joining and leaving groups

A course can be divided into groups (e.g for working in groups during the course). Lecturer notifies the students if there is a requirement for them to join a group.

- 1. Go to menu: MY STUDY INFORMATION > My exams / assessments > GROUPS
- 2. The system displays a list of courses that have groups created by the lecturer.
